FIP RISE Frihamnen, from Krakow to Sweden

The **CUPRA FIP Tour** is at home in Sweden. After the two tournaments in **Gothenburg** and Gävle played in the past months, here is another FIP RISE to be played at the Padel Arena Frihamnen, also in the city of Gothenburg. On court, in a men's draw of 29 pairs, three of which have already qualified for the round of 16, will be some players who were stars of the European Games in Krakow a few days ago.

At the top of the seeded list are Frenchmen Thomas Leygue and Jeremy Scatena, who in Poland, in the men's doubles, were defeated by a Swedish pair (Andersson-Olsson). On the other side of the draw, Spanish Cayetano Rocafort Lores and Swedish Simon Vasquez, who have already won the FIP RISE in Gothenburg in Sweden, as well as the FIP **PROMOTION Diputacion Malaga** (Spain). Also from France is the third pair directly to the second round, composed by Jerome Inzerillo and Maxime Moreau.
