This weekend, at Santo Stefano Padel & Tennis in **Biella**, a **FIP RISE** is being played, with Italian **Simone Cremona** and **Marco Cassetta** leading the list of top seeds in a 32-pair draw. On the other side, numbers 2 in the seeding the Argentine **Nahuel Pineda** and Mexico's **Pablo Acevedo Iturribarria**. Number 3 **Alessandro Tinti** and **Federico Galli**, number 4 the Canadian **Karl Shafik Mouchantaf** and the Spaniard **Luis Ortega Perez**.

Curiosity for the young **Noa Bonnefoy**, who won the **FIP PROMISES** at the **Foro Italico** paired with **Spurio** last weekend. This time, he will play with **Edoardo Sardella**. In the women's, 21 pairs will be at the starting line-up: the top 11 seeds will go straight into the round of 16, with Italy's **Martina Parmigiani** and Spain's **Carla Fito** the number 1 seed.
