FIP PROMISES Middelkerke, next gen on court in Belgium

The **CUPRA FIP Tour** weekend includes a stage of the **FIP PROMISES** circuit in Belgium, at the Golden Point in **Middelkerke**, a city in West Flanders. As many as five draws are scheduled, three men's and two women's. In the men's, Chilean **Vicente Soto** and Spaniard **Alvaro Bartolome** (Under 14), Dutchmen **Thomas Panken** and **Floris Janssen** (Under 16), and compatriots **Jort Nolten** and **Danill Van Dijk** (Under 18) lead the list of seeded players.

If the Under 14 draw will be knockout, the Under 16 and Under 18 will be played on a round robin. In the women's (both round robin tournaments), Belgian Roxy Van Vonterghem and Ines Alvarez are the number 1 seed in the Under 16, while in the Under 18, Amber De Visccher and Keela Goossens lead the entry list.
