FIP RISE Squadra Santa Maria, Egea looking for another trophy

A week after winning the **FIP RISE** in **Iquique** (Chile) paired with **Gonzalo Vera**, Argentina's **Pablo Nicolas Egea** is looking for another trophy, this time in **Brazil**. The **FIP RISE Squadra Santa Maria**, in the state of **Rio Grande do Sul**, is being played next weekend.

Egea will play with Argentine **Gonzalo Daniel Frete**: they will be the number 3 seed, with the number 2 pair on the other side of the draw, **Adrian Perez** (Paraguay) and **Andre Freitas** (Brazil), with Perez having been Frete's partner in the **FIP RISE** in **Curitiba**, also in Brazil. The two players who were initially at the top of the entry list, **Joao Pedro** and **Stefano Palma Flores**, will not play. Thirty pairs will be at the start, with first round on Friday, round of 16 and quarters on Saturday, semifinals and final on Sunday.
