FIP RISE Chiba, Guichard and Scatena from Paris to Japan

The **CUPRA FIP Tour** returns to **Japan**. After the one in **Osaka**, here is another **FIP RISE**: it will be played in Chiba, with mostly local players.

Leading the draw are two Frenchmen, **Dylan Guichard** (who recently played the Greenweez Paris Major Premier Padel paired with another Frenchman, Bastien Blaque) and **Jeremy Scatena** (the only top 100, currently occupying the number 99 ranking position, and playing at Roland Garros with Brazilian Francisco Gomes) while, on the other side, as the number 2 seed, are Spaniard **Javier Navarro Perez** and Kuwaiti **Mohammed Saadon Alkuwari**.

The third seeded pair, **Abdulla Alhijji** and **Jesus Ruiz Bohorquez**, also consists of a Spanish and a Kuwaiti player.
