FIP PROMISES Ecuador, many local talents on court

This weekend, the **FIP PROMISES Tour** makes a stop in **Ecuador**, with many local talents on court at the **Portoviejo Padel Club** with the aim of winning one of the four titles: men's **Under 14**, **Under 16** and **Under 18** and women's **Under 16**.

The only player to have already accumulated ranking points is the Under 18 **Diego Martinez**: for the others, all from Ecuador, it will therefore be a unique opportunity. The four tournaments will be played with a round robin formula: five pairs at the start in the Under 16 and Under 18 men's, three each for the Under 14 men's and Under 16 women's.
