On the other hand, it was the number 4 pair on the draw who won the women's tournament: raising the trophy were **Carla Fito Fernandez** and **Maria Portillo Perez**, thanks to a 7-5 7-6 victory in the final over **Tia Louisa Norton** and **Rosalie Van der Hoek**. *"We won four matches in which we improved as a couple and were able to take the title – said the winners –. We are very happy with the level of the court and we had fun. Thanks to all the people of Kuwait for their kindness and generosity shown at all times".*
