In order to participate in the National Team Championship, it is essential to present a team of at least six (6) players in the male and/or female category.

Deadline for Submitting National Team rosters via FIP Form: September 27

Deadline to change a team member in case of justified injured: October 25

Note: A roster change due to injury requires immediate notification accompanied by a valid medical certificate. This certificate must detail the nature of the injury, along with the anticipated recovery timeframe. Physiotherapist certifications will not be accepted in this instance.

COMPETITION INFORMATION

General rules:

Line-up submission and order of play:

- One (1) hour before the first match of the tie, the coach must submit the team's line-up with the three pairs. A copy of the opposing team's line-up, including the order of play as listed on their form, will be exchanged with the other coach.
- All three matches are mandatory to be played during the group stage.
- The order of play will be:
 - Pair Number 3
 - Pair Number 2
 - Pair Number 1

Line-up changes:

- Once submitted, line-up changes are only permitted in the following instances:
 - Confirmed injury by the tournament medical team prior to the first tie match.
 - Incorrect line-up submitted initially.
- Any casualty during the elimination will be considered as a lost match by 6/0 6/0.

Pre-match procedures:

• Prior to each match, the referee will verify player identification. Players may present a copy, photograph, or the original passport.

Completion of all matches:

All group stage matches must be played in their entirety.

Third match discretion during position stage:

• In the event of a 2-0 elimination result, both captains need to agree on not playing the last match, although FIP may decide to forego the third match.

Coaching regulations:

- Only accredited coaches from the participating delegation are permitted to sit on the benches, with a maximum of one coach permatch.
- During the first game and any tie break changeovers, coaches can't talk with their players. (First violation will result in a warning).

Score sheet signing:

• Following each tie, coaches must sign the score sheet to validate the results. Failure to sign will result in a 3-0 forfeit of the entire tie.

PLAYERS PLAYING OUTFIT

Teams must wear the patch of the World Padel Championships.

To maintain a unified team appearance, all competing players are required to wear the Federation's official national kit, ensuring uniformity in branding and color.

Team members must wear identical uniforms and refrain from displaying logos of any third party, including unauthorized tournaments, national, continental, or international associations/federations.

In the event that both teams competing in a match share identical colors, the higher-ranked team will have the privilege of wearing their primary uniform. The lower-ranked team will be obligated to select an alternate uniform color.

(Please note that each team is required to have two distinct national kit colors)
