

TEAM DELEGATION

Federative member: one (1) per nation.

All players must have the nationality of the country they represent and not have represented another country in the last thirty-six (36) months to the event, they must also be in possession of a valid license of the country they represent and be exempt from sanctions.

In order to participate in the National Team Championship, it is essential to present a team of at least six (6) players in the boys and/or girl's category.

- Deadline for Submitting National Team Rosters via FIP Form: August 2
- Deadline to change a team member in case of justified injured: August 30

Note: A roster change due to injury requires immediate notification accompanied by a valid medical certificate. This certificate must detail the nature of the injury, along with the anticipated recovery timeframe. Physiotherapist certifications will not be accepted in this instance.

ELEGIBLE YEARS

Under 14: Players born between 2010 & 2012. **Under 16:** Players born between 2008 & 2009. **Under 18:** Players born between 2006 & 2007.

PLAYERS PLAYING OUTFIT

Players of the same team must wear the same colors and refrain from wearing logos from other tours / CONTINENTAL OR INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATIONS.

If both teams on the same tie have the same color, the higher-ranking team will have the preference, and the lower ranking team shall change to another color. (two national kits colors are mandatory for each team).
