## **REGULATIONS**

Deadline to change a team member in case of justified injured:

- Phase 1: 4 of July
- Phase 2: 7 of July

#### LINE-UP TEAM

Coach must give the list of the 3 pairs to the main referee 1 HOUR BEFORE the first game of each tie.

A copy of the other team's line up will be exchange in that moment with the other coach.

Order of play:

- Pair number 3
- Pair number 2
- Pair number 1

From that moment no changes of the team composition will be accepted except:

- Injury proved by the physiotherapist before the start of the first match of each tie.

If any withdrawal comes during the games, the pair will lose by 6-0 / 6-0 that match.

Before each match, the referee will check the names and the passports (each player need to bring their passports / id or a picture of it)

To take into account the scores, the final score sheets need to be signed by each coach. (the no signage of the score sheet means the lost of the tie 3-0)

#### **PLAYERS PLAYING OUTFIT**

Players of the same team must wear the same colors and refrain from wearing logos from other tours / CONTINENTAL OR INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATIONS.

If both teams on the same tie have the same color, the higher-ranking team will have the preference, and the lower ranking team shall change to another color. (two national kits colors are mandatory for each team)
