First in each group will play a final to qualify for the Final Phase

13 Europe qualification (3 groups of 3 teams and 1 of 4 teams)
First in each group will play a semifinal to qualify to Final Phase

16 teams (4 groups of 4)
First two teams of each group play for positions 1- 8.
Last two teams of each group play for positions 9 - 16.
All positions must be defined.

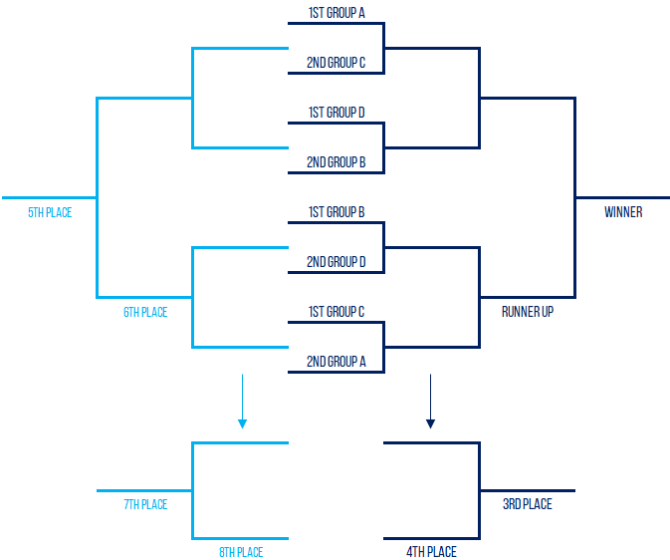

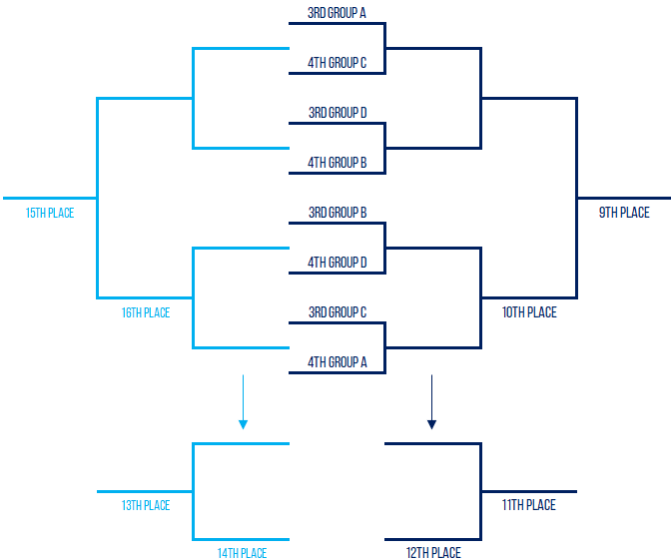

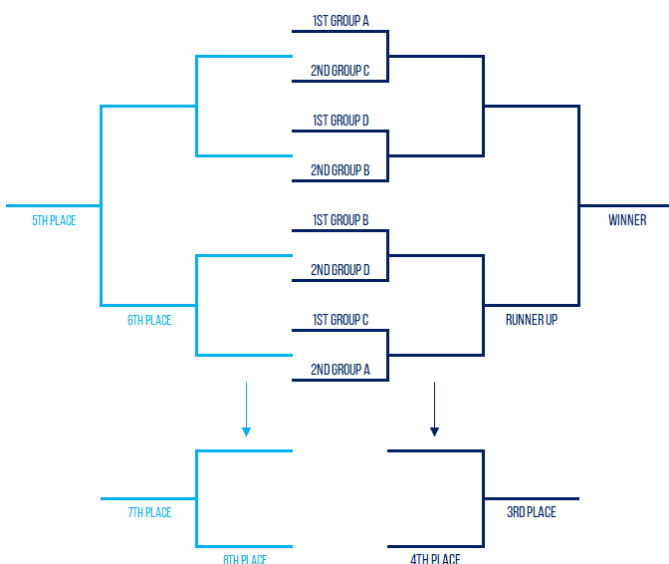

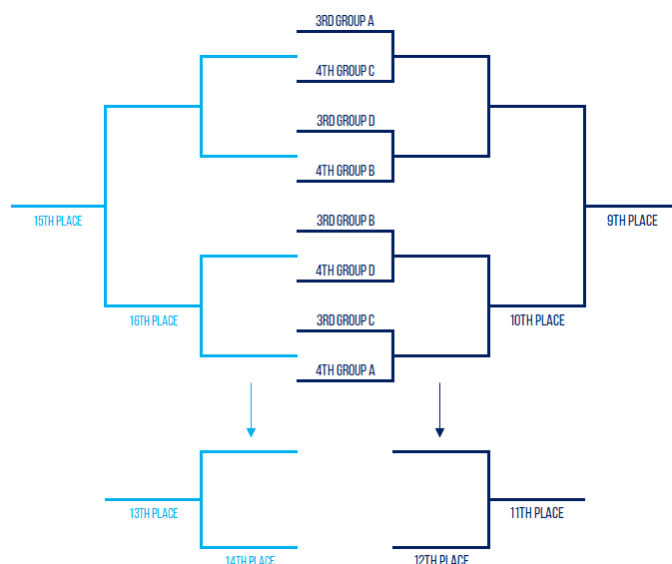

WORLD NATIONAL PAIRS CHAMPIONSHIPS

- Registration deadline: 3 September 2025
- Registration deadline for Wild Cards request, in case of uncompleted draws: 15 September 2025
(Point III.4.4 of the Technical Rulebook IPF World Juniors Championships)
- Registration deadline for countries advancing from the qualification phase of the Team Championships: 28 September 2025
- Coach accreditations must be requested by sending an email to competition@padelfip.com before September 28th. Coaches from Team competition will be accepted too.
- Draw and schedule release: 8 September 2025
- Main draw (32 pairs): 29 September – 4 October 2025

All pairs from National Teams qualified for the final phase will have two (2) main draw spots. A qualification draw won't take place (for more information, please see "World Championships Rulebook Juniors, section III.4.8.).

Players on the same team must wear the same colors and refrain from using logos of other Continental or International Associations.

In the event that teams in the same match have matching colors, the higher-ranked team will have preference, and the lower-ranked team will change to a different color. It will be mandatory for each team to bring two sets of different colored uniform.
