Maximum 12 players y 2 coaches y 1 federative member:

• 4 players U14, 4 players U16 and 4 players U18

Note: Players are eligible for national team competition across all age categories, subject to meeting the minimum age requirements for the respective category (e.g., a U14 player may be aligned with a U16 or U18 team).



Players on the same team must wear the same colors and refrain from using logos of other Continental or International Associations.

In the event that teams in the same match have matching colors, the higher-ranked team will have preference, and the lower-ranked team will change to a different color. It will be mandatory for each team to bring two sets of different colored uniform.

LOGOS SIZE

Positions 1 to 3 5 cm vertical x 6,5 cm horizontal

Each delegation must bring an official flag of their country, suitable for hoisting on a flagpole, which will be used during the ceremonial acts of the event. Dimensions: 150cm x 90 cm

WORLD NATIONAL PAIRS CHAMPIONSHIPS

- Registration deadline: 3 September 2025
- Registration deadline for Wild Cards request, in case of uncompleted draws: 15 September 2025 (Point III.4.4 of the Technical Rulebook IPF World Juniors Championships)
- Registration deadline for countries advancing from the qualification phase of the Team Championships: 28
 September 2025
