





FIP WORLD CUP PAIRS

1. The FIP World Cup Pairs will be held under the official rules of the Premier Padel Rulebook, which will be the regulatory framework for the entire competition. However, the most relevant aspects in terms of sport are highlighted below to ensure proper understanding by players, coaches, and organizers.

2. REGISTRATION AND ACCEPTANCE

Registration and acceptance of players in the FIP World Cup Pairs will be based on their combined FIP Ranking as a pair, using the latest FIP Ranking available at the time of the registration deadline.

The registration deadline will be Friday at 5:00 p.m. CET three (3) weeks before the week in which the FIP World Cup Pairs will take place. The registration deadline may be changed by the FIP, in which case such change must be notified.

3. REGISTRATION IN TWO TOURNAMENTS IN THE SAME WEEK

A player may compete in two (2) tournaments held in the same week, provided that it is with the same partner. One of these must be the FIP World Cup Pairs and the other the Main Draw of a Cupra FIP Tour tournament.

All players whose participation in the FIP World Cup Pairs Tournament has ended two (2) days before the start of the Main Draw of the Cupra FIP Tour Tournament and who are duly registered will have their participation automatically confirmed (example: start of the Main Draw on Friday of the Cupra FIP Tour, the loser of Wednesday's match in the FIP World Cup Pairs can play in the Cupra FIP Tour tournament).

In case of not wishing to participate in the Cupra FIP Tour tournament, it will be the responsibility of the pair to notify the FIP Sports Department of their withdrawal from the tournament, providing due documentation.







4. WILD CARDS

Wild Cards are pairs selected by the FIP Word Cup Pairs Tournament to fill designated spots in the draw. Wild Card requests must be made by the pair themselves and always within the deadline specified in the corresponding Tournament information sheet.

All nominations must be approved by the FIP with regard to player eligibility under the Age Eligibility Rule and Integrity Rules, and other limitations in the applicable regulations. Wild Cards will not be official until approved by the FIP.

The format of the final draws and the qualifying draws for the FIP World Cup Pairs will be as follows:

6. RANKING POINTS

The FIP World Cup Pairs will be part of the official competition calendar of the International Padel Federation (FIP), enjoying the same status as any other tournament recognized by the FIP.

Participation in the FIP World Cup Pairs will award points for the FIP Ranking, which may be considered among the best twenty-two (22) computable results that make up the official classification.

Points will be awarded according to the following points system:
