

### Withdrawal Deadline

- Two (2) days prior to commencement of the qualifying draw. Withdrawals made after this date will not receive a refund and may incur fines or penalties.

## ENTRY CRITERIA

### Player Acceptance Order:

1. International (FIP) Ranking
2. National Ranking
3. Tournament Committee Discretion

**Rankings as of 31 December 2025 will be used.**

- Players entering without a nominated partner may be paired with another player at the Tournament Committee's discretion.

### Eligibility Requirements, players must:

- Be at least 15 years old as of 1 January 2026
- Not be suspended or ineligible under FIP or national federation rules
- Be of good standing and character
- Not be restricted by visa or legal conditions preventing participation

## ENTRY METHOD & PADEL LICENSES

All players must enter via both FIP Padel UNO and Padel Australia:

## **VISA**

All international participants require a visa to enter Australia for the 2026 Australian Summer of Tennis and Australian Open. You require a Letter of Invitation citing your correct visa category, then you need to apply for a visa through Australia's Department of Home Affairs.

### **Step 1 | Request your Letter of Invitation**

To apply for and to be approved for a visa as an invited participant, you will need a Letter of Invitation from Tennis Australia. Absolute Immigration will manage your request and you can submit it through this link.

## **AUSTRALIAN OPEN ACCREDITATION**

Australian Open (AO) accreditations will be granted to players who reach the Quarter Finals, valid for January 18–20. This accreditation provides grounds pass access for players to enjoy the first three days of the AO main draw.



## PROMOTIONAL APPEARANCES

- Players may be requested to attend tournament promotional activities.
- Requests will be reasonable and will not conflict with match commitments.

## PLAYER ATTIRE

- Teams are encouraged (but not required) to wear matching outfits.
- Avoid wearing logos from competing tours or conflicting brands.
- If both teams wear similar colours, the higher-ranked team has priority.
